

# REACT

## What is REACT

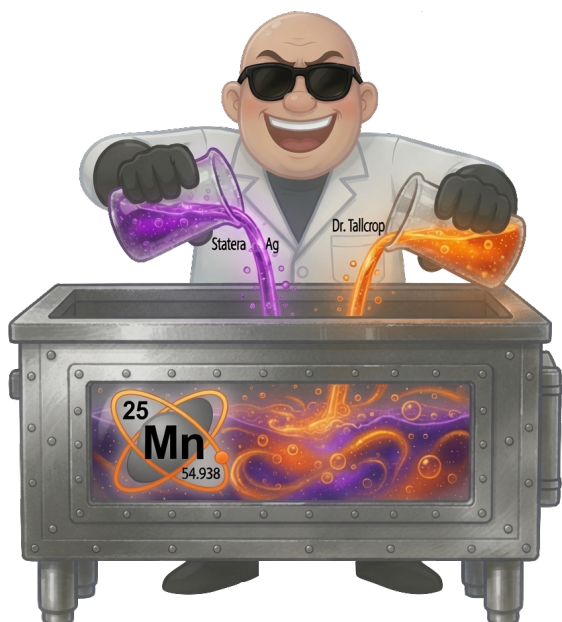
REACT is Manganese tied to an Amino Acid.

Amino Acids help build protein, reduce plant stress, and are a source of Nitrogen.

The addition of an Amino Acid allows for lower use rates compared to standard fertilizer.

Manganese plays an important role in photosynthesis, especially during night cycle.

REACT helps avoid yield drag associated with glyphosate application.



## Recommendations for Use

### Corn

- Add with herbicides, insecticides and fungicides. A standard program is 8 oz/ acre at V4, V10, and R1. Mix into the tank following COC and MSO products.

### Soybeans

- Add with herbicides, insecticides, and fungicides. A standard program is 8 ozs/ acre at R1 and R3. Mix into the tank following COC and MSO products.
- Late-Season Maturation - For soybeans between R6 and R7, apply REACT at a rate of 16 ozs/acre to help support photosynthesis during late maturation.

### Cotton

- Apply REACT at a rate of 8 ozs/acre with herbicides or PGR's. A standard program is 8 oz/ acre with post-emergent herbicide and 8 ozs/acre at first PGR application. Mix into the tank following COC and MSO products.

### Wheat/Triticale

- Apply REACT at 8 ozs/acre with herbicides or late foliar applications. A standard program is 8 ozs/ acre with spring herbicide at green up and 8 ozs/ acre at boot stage.

### Grain Sorghum

- Apply REACT at 8 ozs/acre during late foliar applications. A standard program is 8 ozs/acre at V14 to boot.
